Letter from the Superintendent:

It is a great time to be a Warrior!

This fall has certainly proved to be a great time for the Warriors. This fall we won four CBC league titles and our band has qualified for its third straight state competition! We have implemented several initiatives to increase student achievement and we continue to improve our use of technology. However, the most exciting news might be the building of a new athletic complex.

As I reported last spring, there were several items still needed to complete the campus and an athletic complex was at the top of the list. We have a need for appropriate locker room and training space as well as additional storage out by the athletic fields. The Board of Education was presented with a plan to fund the athletic complex and they voted unanimously to move forward with its construction.

Dave Bollheimer, Treasurer of Northwestern Schools, was able to work with 5/3 Securities to develop a lease plan that would allow us to use our Permanent Improvement levy money to make payments on a new athletic complex. The plan is very similar to what we did years ago to remodel the old elementary school. Permanent Improvement levies are designed specifically to purchase items which will last longer than five years, fund improvements to structures already in place, or to build new facilities. These monies are generally used to build things or purchase things that help us educate our students, the key being that the money must be used for things that are "permanent." We cannot use Permanent Improvement monies to fund salaries, benefits, or supplies. Because we have new buildings, this is the perfect time to use Permanent Improvement money to build an athletic complex. We often hear about government agencies mismanaging money. Northwestern is using its money for the exact purpose the money was intended, and the best part is that it will not raise taxes or take money away from educating our students!



Come join us this winter at one of our many events. Come and feel the enthusiasm and pride our students have as we celebrate what it means to be a Warrior.

Northwestern Elementary has started a STEM lab/makerspace for the kids to explore engineering ideas and more. During the last couple of


